Before completing the application form, please read these eligibility requirements.

- Applicants **must be** a full-time registered student, studying for a first degree and have at least 5 academic terms remaining to complete their course. (Foundation degree is not eligible until they commence their first-degree).
- Applicants **must be** 18 years at point of attestation (Formally joining UAS).
- Have a minimum of GCSE at grade C/4 or Scottish National 5 at grade C (or equivalent) in English Language and Maths.
- Applicants nationality **must be** British/Commonwealth/British Protected/Republic of Ireland/Dual (British & Other).
- Commonwealth students are **ineligible** to join a UAS if they have any service commitment in their own country.
- Applicants **are ineligible** if they have any unspent convictions or ASBO still in effect.
- Current UK serving reservists can apply to join the UAS. If successful, can only be a member of one military organization and will need to discharge before attesting to the UAS Volunteer Reserve Service.
